


PROMOTIONAL ASSETS




Sample Assignment: Policy Review

Analyze the NCAA's or a professional sports league's stance on sports wagering and propose improvements based on Know Your Play's principles.

Useful Links

The NCAA's "Draw the Line" initiative prioritizes student athlete education on the integrity of competition among students, effects of sports wagering, and online abuse and harassment of student athletes.

The NCAA's "Sports Betting" page outlines the organization stance on sports betting, highlighting the risks it poses to the integrity of college athletics and student athlete well-being. It provides educational resources, guidance on prohibited activities, and information on the potential consequences of violating gambling rules.

Awareness Campaign

Develop a campus-wide initiative using Know Your Play content to educate students on responsible gaming **OR**Develop a campaign to reduce stigma on problem gambling by framing it alongside other public health issues.

The National Council on Problem Gambling is the only national nonprofit organization that seeks to minimize the economic and social costs associated with gambling addiction. NCPG is neutral on legalized gambling.

The <u>1-800-GAMBLER</u> program run by the NCPG offers confidential support for individuals affected by problem gambling. It features a 24/7 helpline, access to treatment services, self-help tools, and information for loved ones and professionals. It further provides links to state-specific and local support organizations and resources.

Case Study:

Analyze and compare the legalized gaming frameworks of U.S. states, exploring regulations, licensing, consumer protections, and enforcement practices.

Useful Links

The American Gaming Association (AGA) is an industry association which provides an overview of state-specific gambling laws in the U.S., detailing various types of legalized gambling such as casinos and sports betting. It tracks state regulations, economic impacts, tax revenues, and legal developments across 47 states.

The FBI's Crime and Corruption in Sport and Gaming (CCSG) program was created to identify, combat, and disrupt the criminal activities that degrade the integrity of sport and erode public confidence in these institutions. The FBI is working in partnership with leagues, governing bodies, international law enforcement, and independent watchdog groups to identify illegal activity.

Case Study

Examine how the media shapes public perceptions of sports wagering and assess the effectiveness of responsible gaming messaging and advertising.

FACULTY & STAFF GUIDANCE

Higher education is an exciting new chapter, but it also comes with new challenges, risks, and pressures that can be difficult to manage for students, parents, and teachers alike. By understanding these influences and how they exist within the gambling landscape, parents and teachers can be proactive in mitigating risks for the young adults in their life.

WONDERING WHAT YOU CAN DO?

Understand levels of exposure that students may have with gaming

Look out for changes in students which may indicate exposure or a potential problem (irritability, preoccupation with sporting events or mobile devices, requests to borrow money)

Encourage the integration of university gaming policies and prevention initiatives including financial education, and support resources across campus

Have the Conversation

Sometimes, starting a conversation is a hard step. <u>Trusted Voices: Conversations About Betting</u> is designed to equip adults with tools and resources to talk to young people about gambling, including information on warning signs, risks and proxy betting. The program is led by retired NBA player Randy Livingston and his wife, basketball agent Anita Smith, who share their personal stories related to problem gambling, with the hope of preventing others from experiencing similar harms.
